Yagna Topics

Chandogya Upanishad

The Chandogya Upanishad is one of the "primary" (mukhya) Upanishads, and is associated with Sama Veda. Chapter Six of this Upanishad establishes the principle of oneness of Atman with all beings and non-beings. In this chapter, the famous story of Uddalaka and his son Shvetaketu is told and the dialogue between them establishes the principle of oneness of Atman. The Mahavakya "That art Thou" (Tatvamasi) is expounded in this chapter.

Srimad Bhagavatam

Sreemad Bhagavatam is a Mahapurana that focuses on Bhakti Yoga – considered to be the easiest of all Yogas to reach the Supreme Abode. This Purana has twelve Cantos containing various stories of devotees and the various avatars of Lord Vishnu. Sri Veda Vyasa composed Bhagavatam after being inspired by Sri Narada Muni and subsequently taught it to his son, Sukha (Śukadeva Gosvāmī).
